

PSALM 91

Frank dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Frank abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Frank says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, Our God, in whom we trust!" For it is God who delivers Frank from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Frank with His pinions, and under His wings Frank may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Frank will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Frank's side, and ten thousand at his right hand; but it shall not approach Frank. Frank will only look on with his eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Frank has made the Lord, his Refuge, even the Most High, Frank's dwelling place.

No evil will befall Frank, nor will any plague come near Frank's tent.

For He will give His angels charge concerning Frank to guard Frank in all his ways. They will bear Frank up in their hands, lest Frank strike his foot against a stone. Frank will tread upon the lion and cobra, the young lion and the serpent he will trample down.

"Because Frank has loved Me [God said], therefore I will deliver him; I will set Frank securely on high, because Frank has known My name. Frank will call on Me, and I will answer Frank. I will be with Frank in troubles; I will rescue Frank and honor Frank. With a long life I will satisfy Frank, and let him behold My salvation."
