

PSALM 91



Jay Davis dwells in the shelter of the Most High and **Jay Davis** abides in the shadow of the Almighty. **Jay Davis** says to the Lord, “My Refuge and My Fortress, Our God, in whom we trust!” For it is God who delivers **Jay Davis** from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover **Jay Davis** with His pinions, and under His wings **Jay Davis** may seek refuge; God’s faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Jay Davis will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at **Jay Davis’s** side, and ten thousand at their right hand; but it shall not approach **them**. **Jay Davis** will only look on with their eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For **Jay Davis** has made the Lord, their Refuge, even the Most High, **their** dwelling place.

No evil will befall **Mar Jay Davis**, nor will any plague come near **Jay Davis’s** tent.

For He will give His angels charge concerning **Jay Davis** to guard **them** in all their ways. They will bear **Jay Davis** up in their hands, lest **Jay Davis** strike their foot against a stone. **Jay Davis** will tread upon the lion and cobra, the young lion and the serpent they will trample down.
