

PSALM 91

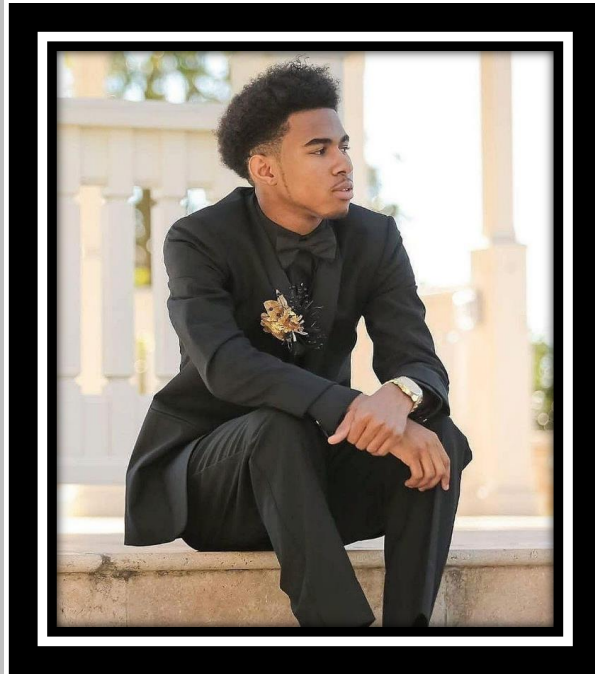
Titus dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Titus abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Titus says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, Our God, in whom we trust!" For it is God who delivers Titus from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Titus with His pinions, and under His wings Titus may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Titus will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Titus's side, and ten thousand at his right hand; but it shall not approach Titus. Titus will only look on with his eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Titus has made the Lord, his Refuge, even the Most High, Titus's dwelling place.

No evil will befall Titus, nor will any plague come near Titus's tent.

For He will give His angels charge concerning Titus to guard Titus in all his ways. They will bear Titus up in their hands, lest Michael strike his foot against a stone. Titus will tread upon the lion and cobra, the young lion and the serpent he will trample down.

"Because Titus has loved Me [God said], therefore I will deliver him; I will set Titus securely on high, because Titus has known My name. Titus will call on Me, and I will answer Titus. I will be with Titus in troubles; I will rescue Titus and honor Titus. With a long life I will satisfy Titus, and let him behold My salvation."
