

Psalm 91

Darla and Jeff dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Darla and Jeff abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Darla and Jeff says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, Our God, in whom we trust!" For it is God who delivers Darla and Jeff from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Darla and Jeff with His pinions, and under His wings Darla and Jeff may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Darla and Jeff will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Darla and Jeff's side, and ten thousand at their right hand; but it shall not approach Darla and Jeff. Darla and Jeff will only look on with their eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Darla and Jeff has made the Lord, their Refuge, even the Most High, Darla and Jeff's dwelling place.

No evil will befall Darla and Jeff, nor will any plague come near Darla and Jeff's tent.

For He will give His angels charge concerning Darla and Jeff to guard Darla and Jeff in all their ways. They will bear Darla and Jeff up in their hands, lest Darla and Jeff strike their foot against a stone. Darla and Jeff will tread upon the lion and cobra, the young lion and the serpent they will trample down.
