



Psalm 91

Kim and Wayne dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Kim and Wayne abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Kim and Wayne says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, Our God, in whom we trust!" For it is God who delivers Kim and Wayne from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Kim and Wayne with His pinions, and under His wings Kim and Wayne may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Kim and Wayne will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Kim and Wayne's side, and ten thousand at their right hand; but it shall not approach Kim and Wayne. Kim and Wayne will only look on with their eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Kim and Wayne has made the Lord, their Refuge, even the Most High, Kim and Wayne's dwelling place.

No evil will befall Kim and Wayne, nor will any plague come near Kim and Wayne's tent.
