







PSALM 91

Brenda Steve dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Brenda Steve abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Brenda Steve says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, My God, in whom I trust!" For it is God who delivers Brenda Steve from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Brenda Steve with His pinions, and under His wings Brenda Steve may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Brenda Steve will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Brenda Steve's side, and ten thousand at her right hand; but it shall not approach Brenda Steve. Brenda Steve will only look on with her eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Brenda Steve has made the Lord, her Refuge, even the Most High, her dwelling place.

No evil will befall Brenda Steve, nor will any plague come near Brenda Steve's tent.
