PSALM 91

Margaret dwells in the shelter of the Most High and **Margaret** abides in the shadow of the Almighty. **Margaret** says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, My God, in whom I trust!" For it is God who delivers **Margaret** from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover **Margaret** with His pinions, and under His wings **Margaret** may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Margaret will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Margaret's side, and ten thousand at her right hand; but it shall not approach Margaret. Margaret will only look on with her eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Margaret has made the Lord, her Refuge, even the Most High, her dwelling place.

No evil will befall Margaret, nor will any plague come near Margaret's tent.

For He will give His angels charge concerning Margaret to guard Margaret in all her ways. They will bear Margaret up in their hands, lest Margaret strike her foot against a stone. Margaret will tread upon the lion and cobra, the young lion and the serpent she will trample down.

"Because Margaret has loved Me [God said], therefore I will deliver her; I will set Margaret securely on high, because Margaret has known My name. Margaret will call on Me, and I will answer Margaret. I will be with Margaret in troubles; I will rescue Margaret and honor Margaret. With a long life I will satisfy Margaret, and let her behold My salvation."
