



PSALM 91



Tina Scroggins dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Tina Scroggins abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Tina Scroggins says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, My God, in whom I trust!" For it is God who delivers Tina Scroggins from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Tina Scroggins with His pinions, and under His wings Tina Scroggins may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Tina Scroggins will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Tina Scroggins' side, and ten thousand at her right hand; but it shall not approach Tina Scroggins. Tina Scroggins will only look on with her eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Tina Scroggins has made the Lord, her Refuge, even the Most High, her dwelling place.

No evil will befall Tina Scroggins, nor will any plague come near Tina Scroggins' tent.

For He will give His angels charge concerning Tina Scroggins to guard Tina Scroggins in all her ways. They will bear Tina Scroggins up in their hands, lest Tina Scroggins strike her foot against a stone. Tina Scroggins will tread upon the lion and cobra, the young lion and the serpent she will trample down.
