

## PSALM 91

Jessie dwells in the shelter of the Most High and Jessie abides in the shadow of the Almighty. Jessie says to the Lord, "My Refuge and My Fortress, my God, in whom I trust!" For it is God who delivers Jessie from the snare of the trapper and from the deadly pestilence [fatal, infectious disease]. God will cover Jessie with His pinions, and under His wings Jessie may seek refuge; God's faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Jessie will not be afraid of the terror by night, or of the arrow that flies by day; of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. One thousand may fall at Jessie's side, and ten thousand at his right hand; but it shall not approach Jessie. Jessie will only look on with his eyes, and see the recompense of the wicked. For Jessie has made the Lord, his Refuge, even the Most High, Jessie's dwelling place.

No evil will befall Jessie, nor will any plague come near Jessie's tent. For He [God] will give His angels charge concerning Jessie to guard Jessie in all his ways. They will bear Jessie up in their hands, lest Jessie strike his foot against a stone. Jessie will tread upon the lion and cobra, the young lion and the serpent he will trample down.

"Because Jessie has loved Me [God said], therefore I will deliver him; I will set Jessie securely on high, because Jessie has known My name. Jessie will call on Me, and I will answer Jessie. I will be with Jessie in troubles; I will rescue Jessie and honor Jessie. With a long life I will satisfy Jessie, and let him behold My salvation."
